A. Items Opening Meeting

1. Call to Order - Mayor Justin Hamilton called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

2. Pledge - Mayor Justin Hamilton led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Roll Call - Village Secretary called roll: Present were: Mayor Justin Hamilton, Councilmember Bobby Amidon, Councilmember Kevin Davis, Councilmember Daniel Mershon. Absent: Mayor ProTem Scott Staeb and Councilmember Jeff Schroeder. A quorum was present.

B. Mayor Report

Councilmember Jeff Schroeder unable to attend this meeting but we are very grateful for his service to our community as a member of this Council since 2023.

C. Canvass of Election and Taking of Oath

1. Canvass of the Village of Point Venture municipal election conducted on November 4, 2025.

Candidates have been certified as unopposed and hereby elected as follows:

Justin Hamilton Mayor, two-year term

Scott Staeb Council Seat, two-year term

Alex Broughton Council Seat, two-year term

Certificate of Election was presented to Justin Hamilton and Alex Broughton.

2. Oaths of Office for Mayor and Council Seats

Village Secretary administered the Statement of Elected Official and Oath of Office to Justin Hamilton, Mayor.

Mayor Justin Hamilton administered the Statement of Elected Official and Oath of Office to Alex Broughton, Councilmember.

D. Public Hearing/Items for Consideration

Pursuant to Section 211.007(e) of the Texas Local Government Code and Section 1.1.11.1(a)(1) of the Village Zoning Ordinance, the hearing will be before the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture as there is not an appointed Village Planning and Zoning Commission.

- Consider testimony and act upon proposed amendments to Chapter 5 of the Zoning
 Ordinance amending residential lot size.
 - a. Mayor Justin Hamilton reported this zoning text amendment revises the minimum lot depth for all lots and minimum lot width for corner lots within SF-1 and SF-2 zoning districts. Mayor Justin Hamilton opened public hearing for comments at 6:38 PM.
 - b. No public comments.
 - No further Council discussion. Mayor Justin Hamilton closed public hearing for comments at 6:39 PM.
 - d. Councilmember Kevin Davis made a motion to approve amendments to Chapter 5 of the Zoning Ordinance as regards all lots minimum depth and corner lots minimum width requirements for SF-1 and SF-2 zoning districts and to adopt these amendments at second and final reading. Councilmember Bobby Amidon seconded the motion. Each member in agreement. Motion carried.

Resident and property owner (lot 585) spoke to Council regarding back yard of residence behind her home has grass and weeds over 5' in height and large dead limbs/branches piled in the high grass. This situation has been reported by resident for firewise review and action since June 2024.
