Mayor Hamilton attended the North Lake Travis Chamber of Commerce luncheon September 19. Fire Chief Donnie Norman of Travis County ESD No 1 was the speaker. Chief Norman commented that the collaboration between the three government entities of Lago Vista, Jonestown and Village of Point Venture has never been stronger. Personnel from both the fire stations undergo many hours of training for preparedness not only in our area, but also national events that may occur outside of Texas. We are proud that Travis County ESD No. 1 is part of and provides safety and security to our community.
