MINUTES

A. Items Opening Meeting

- 1. Call to order Mayor Love called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.
- 2. Pledge Mayor Love led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Roll Call Vickie Knight called roll. Present were Councilmember Don Conyer, Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton, Mayor Eric Love, Councilmember Dan Olson, Councilmember Stephen Perschler. A quorum was present.

4. Consent Agenda

- A. Approval of Council Meetings
 - 1. July 17, 2019 Council Meeting
 - 2. August 21, 2019 Special Called Council Meeting
- B. Approve ATS Building Inspection Service Agreement dated October 1, 2019
- C. Approve Resolution 2019-09-01 regarding Section 61.012 of the Texas Election Code requirement to provide accessible voting system in each polling place used in a Texas election on or after August 1, 2019.

Councilmember Stephen Perschler made a motion to approve consent agenda. Councilmember Don Conyer seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

B. Citizen's Participation

Not for items listed on this agenda. No deliberations with Council, Council may respond with factual information.

- * Resident brought a request to be granted variance for building of workshop and carport.
- * Resident currently running for city council introduced himself to the council.
- * Invitation to community for upcoming events: October 1 National Night Out in POA parking area from 6-8 PM and October 14 Firewise Town Hall Meeting at Lago Vista Community Library Meeting Room at 7 PM.
- *Resident spoke to Council regarding the Village Point Venture permitting process, who is responsible and qualified at the Village to verify and review builder plans.

D. Items to Consider

- Discuss and take possible action to approve fiscal year 2019/20 budget
 Ordinance 2019-09-01 as attached. Councilmember Perschler made a motion to approve fiscal
 year 2019/20 budget. Councilmember Dan Olson seconded the motion. All approved.
 Motion carried.
- Discuss and take possible action to adopt 2019 ad valorem tax rate of \$.1220
 Ordinance 2019-09-02 as attached. Councilmember Dan Olson made a motion to adopt 2019 ad valorem tax rate of \$.1220. Councilmember Don Conyer seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

- 3. Discuss council resolution and resolve regarding the reading and passing of municipal ordinances. Council wishes to edit, clarify and send for attorney review ordinance 2019-08-02 regarding construction and placement of outbuildings within the Village of Point Venture. Council wishes to define administrative ordinances that can be read and passed in one reading but ordinances 'of substance' will follow council resolution 2010-06-03 preferred method of consideration and adoption of ordinances of the Village of Point Venture. Mayor ProTem Clinton expects ordinance 2019-08-02 update to be presented November 21 to develop an all encompassing ordinance defining outbuilding.
- 4. Discuss and take possible action to authorize limestone rock enclosure at Village offices not to exceed \$4,500. Councilmember Perschler discussed options to centralize trash/recycle containers at the Village Office and remove from the WCID parking lot. Estimate received for a limestone rock enclosure of \$4900, verbal estimate of \$1700 to construct wood fencing enclosure. There was resident and council concerns that any trash containers located outside the Point Venture front gate would be overfilled and misused. Mayor Love requested Councilmember Conyer to speak with Fred Marshall, WCID Board President, regarding option to move cans around to area beside the Community Collection Center.
- 5. Discuss requiring new home construction drainage plan and fee agreement. Councilmember Perschler brought item to council to discuss developing a requirement as part of Village of Point Venture building permit process for an engineered drainage plan and associated builder fee. Councilmember Perschler has asked Haynie Construction to provide estimate of cost to submit an engineered drainage plan for remaining lots, the Village would need to consider builder's fee or bond payment for drainage fee review by Village engineer prior to permit issuance.
- 6. Discussion regarding remediation and cost estimate received for Peckham and Lakefront Drive. Councilmember Perschler reported the RFQ (request for quote) required for a project exceeding \$50,000 has multiple legal requirements for a municipality. Councilmember Perschler expects to bring RFQ for council review and approval at the October 16 council meeting.

E. Council Reports

- Treasurer Report Councilmember Olson presented Village of Point Venture financial items/reports
- 2. Building Department Nothing further to report
- 3. Code Enforcement Nothing new to report
- 4. Animal Control Councilmember Conyer reported a fox was picked up from the Village and tested negative for rabies; a skunk was picked up from the Village and did test positive for distemper. Councilmember Conyer asked that all residents with pets keep vaccinations current.
- 5. Village Services Councilmember Conyer reported that 45 residents utilized the Community Collection Center, Saturday September 7. A log of residents utilizing the collection center is maintained of each collection date. Mayor Love asked Councilmember Conyer to ask Fred Marshall, WCID Board President, if Village personnel could use the backhoe housed in Community Collection Center area twice a month to crush down trash in 30 yd container. Councilmember Conyer reported that the Village does own a chipper and staff would be determining if chipper is still operable.
- 6. Public Works Councilmember Perschler reported street striping for area designated has been completed. Effective October 1, 2019, Waste Connections trash/recycle billing will no longer be included within the Travis Co WCID monthly water billing. Waste Connections will bill residents direct for trash and recycling services on a quarterly basis. Waste Connections will also serve as customer service interface for new service, cancel service, missed service, additional service. This information has been sent email to residents, information regarding this change over is also posted on vopv.org website. Direct billing to residents by Waste Connections does not alter Village contract agreement that Waste Connections is franchise provider for trash and recycle services for Village of Point Venture, there is no opt out clause for residents.

- 7. Emergency Services Councilmember Perschler reported the Village of Point Venture has received an ISO rating of 2. The construction and near completion of fire station on Lohmans Ford by Lago Vista High School played a significant role in our ISO rating.
- 8. Travis County Sheriff's Report Sheriff Greg Pasak was in attendance. Sheriff Pasak reported that Travis Co Sheriff will stop vehicles driving recklessly in the Point Venture Park. Summer hours of 70 per month will be cut back to 30 hours per month for Sheriff coverage.
- **F. Announcements** Roy Ables requested that council either follow council resolution 2010-06-03 regarding reading and passing of ordinances or repeal the resolution.

G. Adjourn Councilmember Stephen Perschler moved to adjourn meeting. Mayor ProTem seconded the motion. All approved. Mayor Love adjourned the meeting at 8:15 PM.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-09-01 TO ADOPT A BUDGET

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020, SETTING FORTH THE DETAIL OF THE BUDGET; EFFECTIVE DATE; SEVERABILITY; PROPER NOTICE AND A **MEETING**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 102, Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated, Local Government Code, Section 102.007, municipalities may, after a public hearing is held, adopt a budget for the forthcoming fiscal year: and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Government Code, Section 102, the budget officer, has prepared a budget for the Village of Point Venture for fiscal year 2019-2020, has timely filed the proposed budget with the City Secretary at least thirty days prior to the date of this Ordinance, and has duly presented the budget to the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT **VENTURE:**

- 1. The City Council of the Village of Point Venture hereby adopts the budget attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 for the support, maintenance and operation of the general government of the Village of Point Venture and for the maintenance of streets and roads within the said Village.
- 2. The ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its final passage and approval.
- 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by the valid judgment of decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-09-02 TO ADOPT 2019 AD VALOREM TAX RATE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, LEVYING AND ORDERING COLLECTED AN ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX OF \$.1220 PER \$100.00 VALUATION FOR ALL REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAX WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, TO BE PLACED IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY FOR GENERAL USE BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Village of Point Venture, Texas, has determined that the ad valorem tax rate for real and personal property subject to tax within the City shall be \$.1220 per \$100 valuation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. An ad valorem tax rate for Maintenance and Operations for the general fund of \$.1220 per \$100 cash valuation be hereby levied for the year 2019 on all real, personal and mixed property located and situated within the boundaries of the Village of Point Venture, and the Travis County Appraisal District is ordered and is ordered and required to collect the same.
- 2. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TOTAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE BY 5.6%.
