

Let It Be Noted

- ► On August 19, 2020, the Village Council approved the following:
 - Proposed tax rate of 0.1224/\$100 valuation.
 - FY2021 proposed budget; proposed budget is posted on the Village website.
 - Maximum \$21,000 allocation of funds towards Peckham Drive drainage issue.
- ► On August 19, 2020, Mayor Love announced the resignation of Councilmember Dan Olson.
- ► The Village has three unopposed candidates for three open Council seat positions: Steve Perschler, Steve Hafner, and Terry Petocz.
- ► Work on Fire Station #3 (Boggy Ford) is progressing with a potential opening in the Fall.
- ► Sheriff deputies have increased their security and will be providing weekly reports to the Village. Most of the recent issues are alcohol related and accidental injuries.
- ► WCID/AWR has discontinued all routine repair and maintenance of grinder pumps. Homeowners must contact a plumbing company to service their grinder pumps.

Natural Solutions
